

FAR/DFARS Clauses – Firm Fixed Price Orders under a U.S. Government Contract/Subcontract

The Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) and US Department of Defense Supplement (DFARS) clauses provided in this document are incorporated herein by reference with the same force and effect as if provided in full text. The full text of all FAR/DFARS clauses is available at <https://www.acquisition.gov/> for the FAR clauses and at <http://www.acq.osd.mil/dpap/dars/dfarspgi/current/index.html> for the DFARS clauses

Definitions. Unless otherwise provided, the below FAR/DFARS terms are modified as follows where necessary to derive the proper meaning in a subcontract situation:

- “Contract” or “Schedule” or “Order” means this Purchase Order, Subcontract or related Schedule.
- “Contractor” and “Prime Contractor” and “Offeror” means Seller.
- “Subcontractor” means Seller’s suppliers and/or subcontractors.
- “Buyer” or “Government” means Jabil.
- “Contracting Officer” means Jabil’s Authorized Representative, except for those specific clauses where the context refers to rights, acts, authorizations or obligations that are uniquely performed or granted by the U.S. Government.

However, the words “Government” and “Contracting Officer” do not change: (i) when a right, act, authorization or obligation can be granted or performed only by the Government or the Prime Contract Contracting Officer or duly authorized representative, or (ii) when title to property is to be transferred directly to the Government. Any inconsistencies between the FAR/DFARS clauses and the foregoing terms and conditions shall be resolved by giving precedence to the FAR/DFARS clauses.

Administration. The FAR/DFARS clauses listed below that are not applicable to this Contract due to monetary threshold, place, performance, type of effort or contract shall be treated as self-deleting.

Disputes. The Contract Disputes Act is not applicable to the Contract. Whenever a FAR/DFARS clause includes a requirement for the resolution of disputes between the parties in accordance with the “Disputes” FAR/DFARS clause, the dispute must be disposed of in accordance with the clause entitled “Disputes” as set forth in Jabil’s General Terms and Conditions of Purchase (SCO11885).
